1. Update on AH Foundation check

 And can we do it here?
- What grass seed was used in Cummings & Floral Parks last fall?
- Why can't other woody species be mixed in with piles of buckthorn for pickup? Do they need to be disposed of separately? If we get permission to remove other woody invasive species, how can they be disposed of?
